Dear Brother and friends at home
I or we Rec. the
dreadfull news last Sunday
of the Death of father and
I can hardly realize it as I think
it almost impossible. I wish
I could have seen him once more
but it cant be in this world
but hope in the next. Elias I must be
short in writing this letter as we have
orders to march at 8 O'clock this
morning and it is almost that time
I wish I ~~could~~ could come home
for a short time but it cant
be Elias we left our Camp at
Leeseburg on the 26 inst. and we
marched every day since and yesterday
we crose the line of Pennsylvania
we are within about 4 miles of
Hanover and I think we will
have a fight with the Rebs ear
long. Elias I dont like the idea
of taking Hooker from the command
of the Army Elias I would like
to write you a long letter but
cant now

we dont recive no mail now
and there is gone out but I can
give it to some Citizen and he
will put it in some Post office
as they are willing to do any
thing for us you can read this

the full particulars but get
only know he may ^{be} ⁱⁿ ^{the} ^{army}
on one of us Elias I hope
you will see so every thing is
fixed right concerning father and
have his grave fixed and we will do
our share and as quick as this
Campaign is over I will try and
get home as I would like to see where
he is buried Oh I should liked to see
him once more but god has called
him to a better land. ^{my} ^{love} ^{to} ^{you}
Elia I will close
I remain your loving

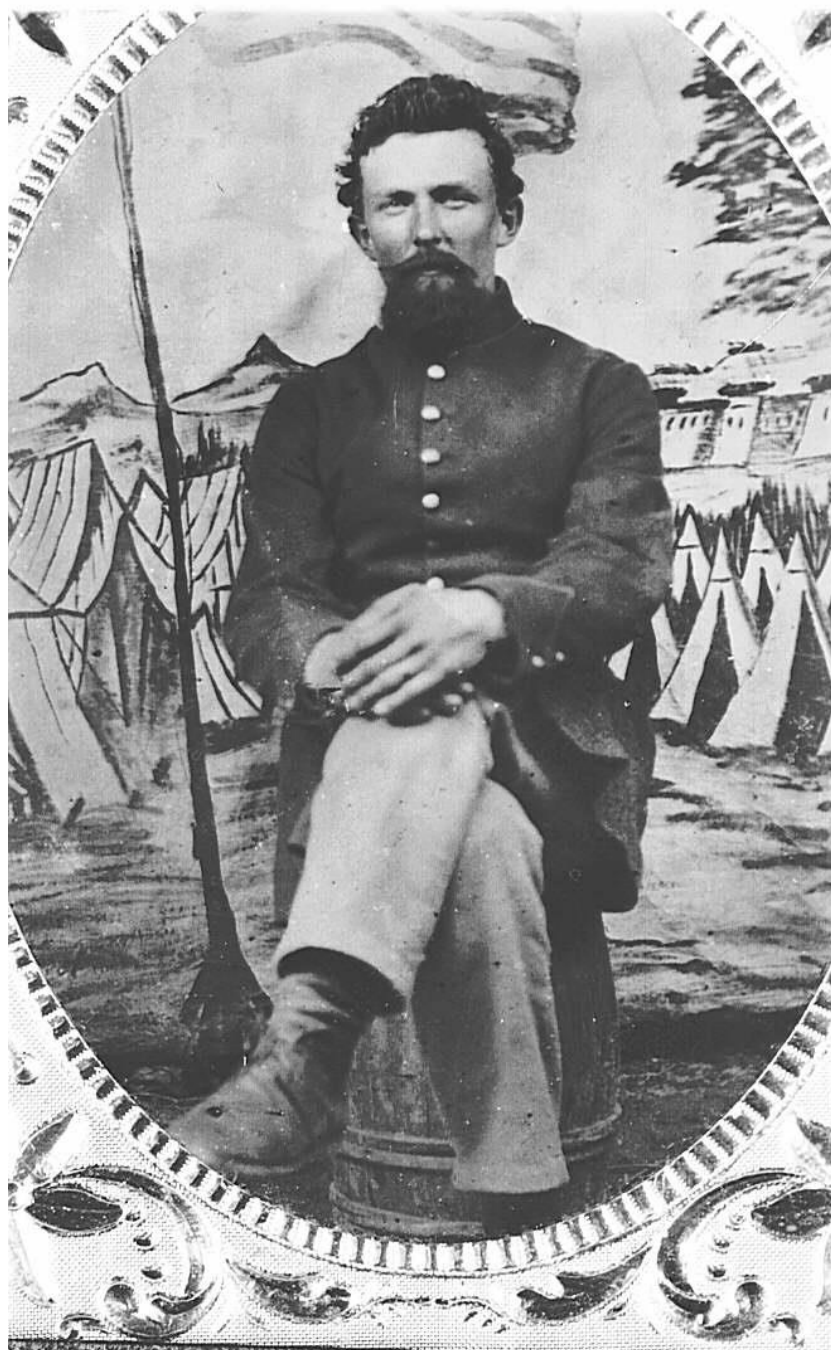
